Subject Overview

8th grade history is the study of United States, it covers the ideas, issues, and events from the early colonial settlements up to the early 20th century. Students examine the shaping of the Constitution, and trace the development of American politics, society, culture, geography, economy and relate them to the emergence of major regional differences. They will learn about the challenges that face the new nation, with an emphasis on the causes and consequences of the Civil War including its aftermath and effects of freedom on former enslaved people.
